

**CALIFORNIA SDM  
SAFETY THREATS**

*All concerns here are  
assessed at the threshold of  
Imminent Danger of Serious Harm*

1. Physical harm/threat of harm
2. Sexual abuse
3. Immediate needs not met
4. Hazardous living conditions
5. Child is a danger to self or others
6. Does not protect the child from serious harm or threatened harm by others
7. Questionable explanation
8. Refuses access or may flee
9. Domestic violence
10. Other (specify)

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**CALIFORNIA IN-HOME  
PROTECTIVE INTERVENTIONS**

1. Direct intervention by worker
2. Use of family, neighbors, or others as a safety resource
3. Use of community agencies as safety resources
4. Use of tribal agency or ICWA program resources
5. Caregiver protects victim from perpetrator
6. Alleged perpetrator leaves household
7. Non-offending caregiver moves to a safe environment with child
8. Legal action planned or initiated—child remains in the home
9. Other (specify)

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
