
Example: Juvenile Justice

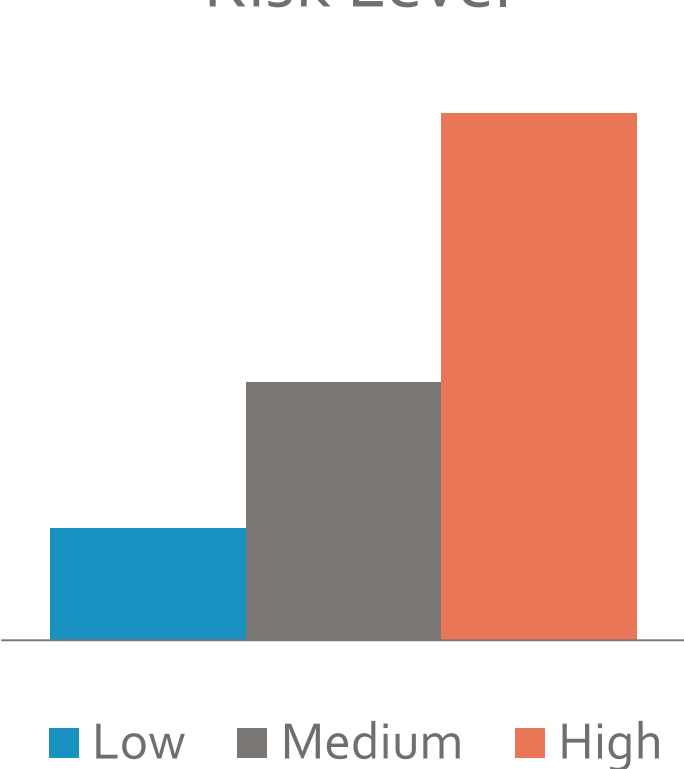

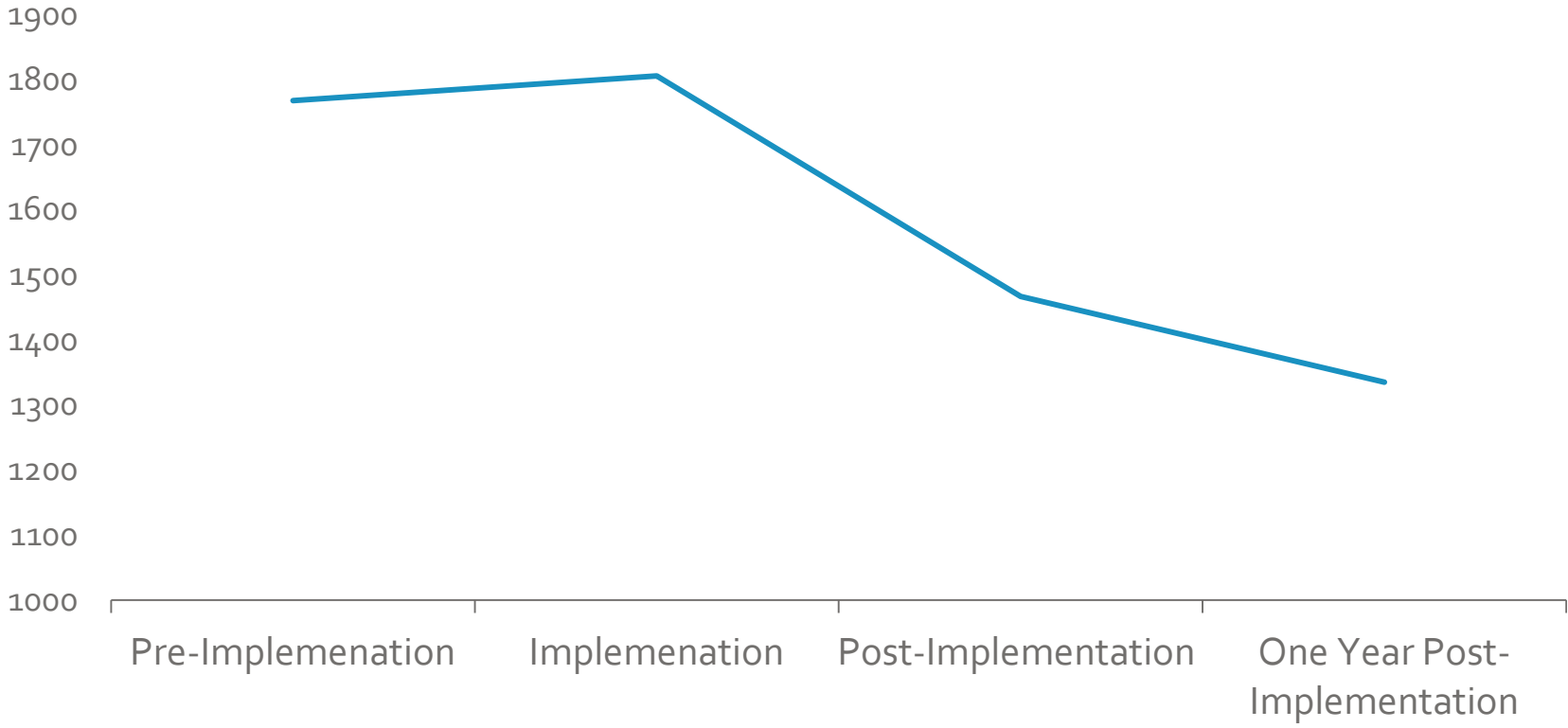


Reform Outcomes
