

Steps for Safety Planning





Assess

Gather information using critical thinking and family engagement skills.



Caregiver actions/inactions and impact on child



Safety threats

STEP 2



Describe

Create at least one statement per safety threat.



Collaborate with family



Clear, concise language

STEP 3



Orient

Explain to the family what a safety plan is.



Necessity due to danger



Behavioral change goal

STEP 4

Creating safety requires more than just the family.



Identify

Identify and help build the network

Engage the network

STEP 5



Safety plans include action steps to keep the child safe.



Identify family/network roles and actions

Develop backup plan

STEP 6



Agree

All participants must agree to the plan.



Willingness/confidence



Capacity

STEP 7

Monitor, Build, Assess Create a timetable and measurements for safety plan review.



Revisit and revise
